With the help of our past treasurer jane Gascoigne, I have paid all our outstanding accounts relating to the changeover and other expenses.


I applied and have received a new eftpos facility linked to our Club Account. Currently, we have 3 eftpos terminals all linked to the Project A/c.

- Expand our reach and improve member engagement and reach


Public Image Director Alyssa Morran
